

Notes from July 15th Meeting with Tammy Hilmey, architect about Chapel Addition:

- Tammy shared drawings of suggested changes both inside the current structure and the new addition.
- Highlights of changes inside that were liked:
 - changing the benches in the lower seating area to have more depth.
 - Removing the benches at the top level, with a more appropriate seat back for those who sit on the second level.
 - Removing the loft and the ladder.
 - A railing(s) that help people move down the first set of central stairs.
- Suggestions that seemed to be passed on:
 - Moving tabernacle from back right of chapel to front left. The tabernacle old space would become a bathroom
 - A wraparound external deck on the left hand side of chapel that would provide access to the front deck and the doors in the rear.
- Description of the addition
 - Plenty of space for coats, shoes, seating to remove shoes.
 - A storage space to the left, a bathroom to the right
 - The architecture/design would be in line with the currently chapel.
 - A trail to the basement would start further out, gradually go down the hill, potentially with a handrail. With a bathroom up top, this path will not be used as often as now.
 - Access via car will be easier with a more defined circle and concrete pathway and apron in front of the entrance. Potentially heated to reduce ice build up.
- Not much detail was discussed, but project as was being discussed seemed less than \$100K, and 3-4 months to complete.
