

2025-2026 has been a year of growing for student ministry, as well as other areas of student activity with and for the Mountain.

To date:

- 3 student communications interns
 - Evie - works directly with Mary G. on data entry and organization, constituent updates in Blackbaud, postcards, mailings and communications; works with Michelle on clerical work as needed
 - Audney - works directly with Natalie on publicity, hanging flyers, social media (reels, videos, more hands-on posts), collecting student reflections for newsletters; works with Mary G. on e-newsletter
 - Audney will graduate in May, and we will need to find another student for this role (if Evie does not want to move on from her current role)
 - Alexis - works directly with Natalie on advertising, updating event flyers, social media (photo carousels, static posts, stories/highlights, collaboration with UMin and FCSC accounts); works with both Natalie and May G. on event registration pages; works with Mary G. on friar birthday cards and notes, etc.
- 5 student drivers
 - Each student is responsible for one Sunday a month, with one student alternate who takes driving shifts as needed when drivers have conflicts
- 8 student Mountain Community Leaders
 - Twice monthly meetings of meditation, reflection and sharing, agenda, planning, etc.
 - Students choose the events they are able to attend and have been stepping up to fill different roles for each opportunity at the Mountain as well as starting to take on some leadership during planning meetings
 - Students nominate and decide as a group which students would be a good fit to invite to MCLs in new semesters/school year

- Group decided that students staying for graduate programs can and should continue to be in leadership with MCLs
- All MCLs are cleared to drive Mountain vehicles, and share driving responsibilities as a group
- 19 individual clubs took the opportunity to come to the Mountain this year
 - New/returning after a hiatus:
 - Theatre
 - ASBMB
 - Women's soccer
 - The Buzz
 - Men's basketball
 - Others that wanted to come but could not get on the spring schedule:
 - Choir (plans to come in the early fall)
 - Military Aligned Students
 - ASIA
 - Women's basketball (will hopefully come over the summer)
- 26 rides offered for Sunday Mass and brunch over the course of two semesters
- 48 student experiences offered at the Mountain this school year
- 1,098 student visits to the Mountain from July-April (overall student visits)
