Mountain Advancement Report April 24, 2021

Mountain Fund

Our Mountain Fund donations continue to increase making this the most successful Mountain Fund effort we have had in our history. Once again thank you to all who have donated and to Marv, Mary G. and the entire advancement team for all your dedication and effort to help us achieve this level of giving. To date, we have far exceeded our financial goal (\$245K) and our stretch goal (\$250K), as well as the number of gifts donated--- 320 more than the prior year.

2020-2021 Stretch Goal: \$250,000

As of 4/14/21-\$311,181.11 from 1337 gifts (124% of goal of \$250K)

* (committed figures that include unpaid pledges totaling \$10,750, not including unpaid recurring gifts)

As of 4/14/20- \$218,420.69 from 1017 gifts (93% of goal \$250K) As of 4/14/19 -\$205,522.15 from 1030 gifts (89.4% of goal \$230K)

Our focus on improving our ability to give online, is showing in the numbers---with almost a quarter of all gifts coming from our website vs. a fifth last year. (We have had many memorial gifts this year).

We currently have 100 new donors this year, or 14% of all donors. Importantly, the median gift amount has gone from \$50 to \$87.

We currently have a 62% donor retention rate.

To date, 404 alumni gave 772 gifts for a total of \$175,115 and 346 non-alumni gave 558 gifts for a total of \$125,366.11.

Even though we have surpassed our goal, *there is still great opportunity*. Our objective between now and the end of the fiscal year: to target 267 individuals that gave last year but not this year.

Overnights

Budgeted Goal: \$15,000 (lower than in past years as we have been shut down to visitors since early March and our overnights and other money given at the Mountain (i.e. Sunday Mass) will be significantly affected

As of 4/14/21 - \$19,155 from 52 gifts and 44 donors (127.7% of goal of \$15,000)

As of 4/14/20- \$24,510 from 122 gifts and 102 donors (65% of goal of \$37,500)

Fr. Dan Riley Sustainability Campaign (Endowment/Major Giving)

Major gift: Contribute \$10,000 or more over a period of no longer than 5 years in addition to annual gifts (Mountain Fund and Auction).

Budgeted Goal: \$3.1 Million

Current Endowment Total to Date: \$720,500.67 committed from 645 gifts and 180 donors. This includes \$58,315.82 in pledges that are still due.

(These numbers are from our current endowment campaign which began in 2012)

- 6/1/20 to 4/14/21: \$40,656.18 committed from 44 gifts. These were all pledge payments with the exception of \$100.
- Although we continue to reach out to donors, we are waiting for our strategic plan to be in place
 before we move forward with major asks. Strategy: to communicate/steward major donors, ask
 for involvement with the strategic planning process (outreach). Several major gift donors were
 involved in the interview process with out strategic planner.
- FYI: Other historical sources of contributions to our current Endowment Account: In an endowment campaign that began in 2003 and ended in 2011, we raised \$1,350,000. For over 20 years and ending in 2015, 10% of all Mountain Fund Donations were allocated to this endowment account.

Stewardship

 Due to the pandemic, we will push out the Living Stones weekend scheduled for April to a later date, tentatively Spring 2022. Living Stones will continue to be an important vehicle for us to stay connected and steward those who have been highly committed to the life of the Mountain.

Total Balance: \$631,144.53 committed from 338 gifts and 74 donors. There is still \$50,100 in unpaid pledges.

June 2019 to April 2020 - \$18,268.73 from 27 gifts from 6 donors.

June 2018 to April 2019- \$55,034.30 from 40 gifts from 11 donors.

*Total reflects new donor dollars from current Bonas campaign (June 1 to Jan 31 of that fiscal year).
