Br. Giacomo Bini, OFM visited Mt. Irenaeus in the 1990's when he was Minister General. At that time, he was already conceptualizing what we now call "new communities." Giacomo was moved by the life, the quiet setting and beauty of the land and meeting with some SBU students. He later asked Daniel Riley, OFM, to write a piece for the book he assembled, "Signs of the Times." This small book told stories from various places around the world that were practicing new life in response to this "new time." Much later, we were thrilled with the Order's 2017 document *Ite, Nuntiate* as it calls for new communities that are strikingly similar to the life we are already living here.

In October 2023, Daniel Riley, OFM and Kevin Kriso, OFM were invited by the Order's Prayer and Devotion Commission to attend an international gathering of Asian, African, European, South, Central and North American friars in Assisi. The friars came from 19 different Houses of Prayer/ or Hermitage Fraternities who were all inspired by the Order's 2017 Document *Listen and You Will Live; Guidelines for the Establishment of a Hermitage or House of Prayer*. At this gathering, current Minister General Massimo Fusarelli, OFM listened to and encouraged our efforts to be contemporary expressions of Contemplative Fraternities in Mission and help spur ongoing renewal in the Order.



We invite other brothers who are interested in our Gospel manner of life and ministry to come and spend time here with us for a longer or shorter period of time. Our life is open to brothers in initial formation as well as the more "seasoned" who yearn to find a proactive balance of ad intra and ad extra.
